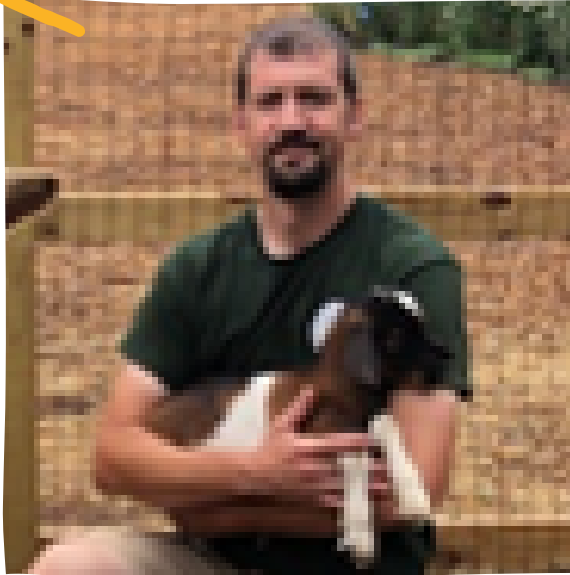


Meet the Teacher
